**Overview:** The TTS Core Training is an intensive 4-day, in-person, evidence-based training program designed for persons who deliver moderate to intensive tobacco treatment services within health care or community setting. The curriculum is designed to address a set of core competencies for tobacco treatment specialists.

**What is a Tobacco Treatment Specialist (TTS)?** A Tobacco Treatment Specialist is a professional who possesses the skills, knowledge and training to provide effective, evidence-based interventions for tobacco dependence for all forms of tobacco and nicotine use. TTSs are trained to develop individualized treatment plans and facilitate client involvement in treatment.

**Target Audience:** Advanced practice providers, health educators, mental health counselors, nurses, pharmacists, physicians, respiratory therapists, social workers, and other health care professionals who treat tobacco and nicotine users.



University of Massachusetts Tobacco Treatment Specialist Training and Certification Program is accredited by The Council for Tobacco Treatment Training Programs (CTTP)

**Training Prerequisite:** Prior to attending the TTS training, all candidates must successfully complete the [Basic Skills for Working with Smokers](#) online course. Please note there is a \$175 fee payable to the University of Massachusetts to register for this course. Participants must also be tobacco-free for 6 months prior to the TTS Core training.

## Indiana Disordered Gambling Clinical Consultant Calls

✓ These calls are intended for **any** counselor who would like to improve skills. These calls provide the opportunity for counselors to present or learn about a disordered gambling client case study and then discuss treatment. This is a wonderful opportunity to ask questions of a National Council on Problem Gambling Board Approved Clinical Consultant (BACC). These calls will also provide participants with 1 CEU.

✓ All contracted disordered gambling provider counselors are required to participate in at least two of these calls per year. This includes lead disordered gambling counselors as well as disordered gambling counselors with or without an IPLA license.
