Gaming and Betting by Adult 60 Year Old and Older in Indiana - 2005

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Executive Summary

The FSSA Division of Mental Health and Addiction sponsored a survey of people in Indiana age 60 years old and over to determine the extent of gaming and betting for money. In June 2005 the Survey Research Center at IUPUI conducted the survey and compiled this report. A random sample of people throughout Indiana age 60 and older was contacted by telephone. This resulted in a total of 762 interviews with a response rate of 33.6 percent.

Almost 80 percent of Indiana adults 60 or older have engaged in some sort of gaming or betting for money at some point in their lives. However, only about one third of this age group has gambled in the past month. Close to half of the men in this age group report gambling in the past month whereas only about a third of women this age have gambled in the same time period. Past month gambling drops from about half of those in their early 60's to only about a quarter of those in their 80's and beyond.

For the most part, trends in reported lifetime, past year and past month gambling all reflect essentially the same rank order of gambling modalities. Lottery tickets are, by far, the most popular form of gaming among this age group. Roughly two-thirds have purchased lottery tickets at some point in their lives and about a third have purchased them within the past month. Another type of gaming similar to the lottery ranks second. Pull-tabs have been played by almost half of those age 60 and older in their lifetimes and about 15 percent report playing them in the past month. At some point in their lives, roughly one-third of people in this age group have played cards or bingo for money or bet at the horse track or at a casino. But only five percent or less report participating in this type of gaming in the past month.

If respondents reported that they had participated in a particular form of gaming or betting in the past 12 months they were asked to report the largest amount they had ever won and lost (or spent) at this activity. The largest amount ever won (averaging several thousand dollars) were associated with institutionalized gambling venues: casinos and horse racing. The largest losses (averaging between \$500 and \$700) were associated with horse racing and betting on sporting events.

Respondents who reported ever engaging in a particular type of gambling were also asked at what age they first played this game for money. The average earliest age (about 25) at which respondents reported gaming for money referred to playing cards or games of personal skill (such as bowling or pool) for money. The games that are currently most popular with this age group (lottery and pull-tabs) are games that the average senior citizen did not start until after they turned 50 years old.

Modified questions were asked using the DSM-IV criteria for substance use to determine if gambling has had a negative impact on those who have gambled at all in the past year. So few respondents responded positively to any of the symptoms it was determined that this approach was not an effective measure of problem gambling.

Introduction

The Indiana FSSA Department of Mental Health and Addiction (DMHA) commissioned the Indiana University Public Opinion Laboratory (IUPOL)¹ to conduct a telephone survey of Indiana residents 60 years old and older. The purpose of the survey was to ascertain the extent of gambling among older Indiana residents. The questionnaire was developed by DMHA with assistance from the IUPOL. A copy of the final questionnaire used in the survey can be found in Appendix A: The Questionnaire.

Survey Methodology

The interviews were conducted by professional interviewers at the IUPOL from our special facilities in Walker Plaza on the Indiana University-Purdue University Indianapolis campus. All interviewers received at least nine hours of general interviewer training, in addition to the more than one hour of specific training on the youth gaming questionnaire. Most of the interviewers were “veteran” interviewers in the sense that they had participated in similar research projects previously. Some have been interviewers for the Public Opinion Laboratory for over five years.

The maximum margin of error for the survey does not exceed 3.4% at a 95% confidence interval. Of course, additional error may result from things such as question wording, respondents’ inattention, pace of speech by the interviewer, and respondents’ willingness to honestly answer individual items. Each of these is given special attention during the questionnaire design and data collection phases so total survey error is minimized as much as possible. We have no reason to believe there are major biases in the data collected for this research.

The interviews for the survey were conducted during May 2005. Calls were made between the hours of 10 a.m. and 9:30 p.m. Each interviewer was given a set of answers entitled “What the Respondent Might Like to Know” which were to provide standard responses to questions raised by the people contacted for an interview. The sample of telephone numbers was obtained from Survey Sampling, Incorporated. In addition all calls were monitored and 10% of all completed

interviews were verified by supervisors. All “non-contacts” such as answering machines or no answers were reattempted at least 10 times.

Each interview began with the interviewer dialing a telephone number distributed by the CATI system. The person answering the phone at each residence is referred to as the informant. When the informant answered the telephone the interviewer read the introduction explaining the purpose of the study to the informant. The interviewer then asked the informant whether they were any household members 60 years old or older. If the informant indicated that there were eligible respondents at that telephone number the interviewer asked the informant to provide the number of those of that age currently living in the household. If there was more than one eligible respondent, the respondent with the most recent birthday was selected to do the interview.

The interviewer then asked to speak to the eligible respondent. A callback was scheduled if the selected respondent was not at home. Response rates were calculated using the formulas suggested by the American Association for Public Opinion Research (On the web: <http://www.aapor.org>). A total of 3,795 phone numbers were called resulting in 762 completed interviews. The final outcome of each number attempted can be categorized into the following dispositions shown in Table 1:

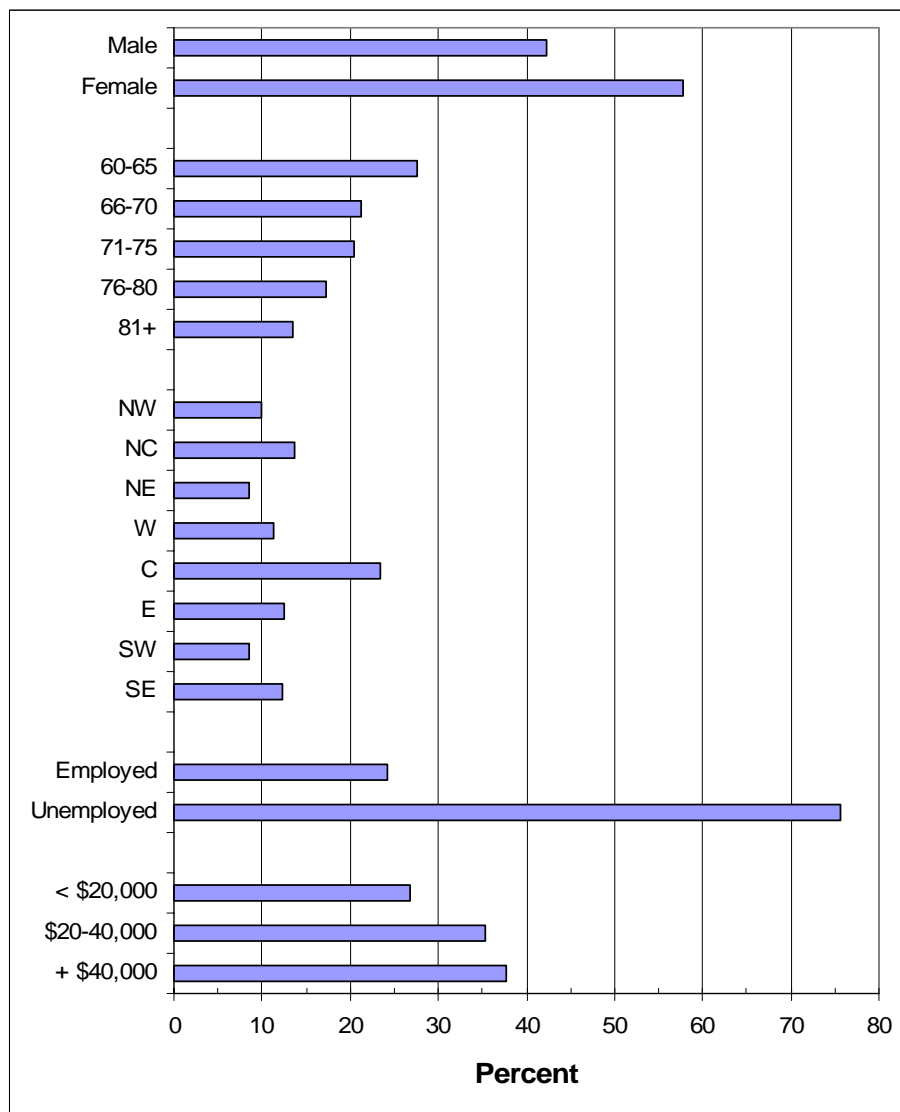

Following the American Association for Public Opinion Research’s Standard Definitions and using an estimate of the proportion of cases of unknown eligibility that were actually eligible, the survey achieved a response rate of 33.6 percent.

Findings

The sample used for this study was comprised of random telephone numbers of household throughout Indiana. The respondents that resulted from this approach were found to be representative of the population of Indiana age 60 years old and over based on recent Census findings for Indiana. One of the goals of the study was to examine the gaming and betting habits of elder Indiana citizens based on several important demographic characteristics. These characteristics, shown in Figure 1, will be used through this report in examining the prevalence of gambling in Indiana among those 60 and older.

Figure 1. Demographic Characteristics of the Sample (N=762)



There were a total of 762 respondents to the study. The demographic categories reflect the known characteristics of this population in Indiana. For example, there are about twice as many respondents age 60 through 65 than there are over 80 years old and significantly more women than men. The geographic regions used in this report are the FSSA Administrative Regions defined by DMHA; the most populated is the Central region and the least are the Southwest and Northeast regions. See Appendix B for a map of these regions. Only about one in four people 60 or older report being currently employed. As one might expect, those under 65 were most likely to report they were employed and have incomes over \$40,000. However, respondents who were not employed were fairly evenly distributed across income categories.

Prevalence of Any Type of Gambling

Almost 80 percent of Indiana adults 60 or older have engaged in some sort of gaming or betting for money at some point in their lives. The results shown in Table 2 reveal that about over one third in this age group have gambled in the past month. Of those who gamble, the average gambler reports having tried at least two different types of gambling in their lifetimes.

Men are much more likely to partake in gambling than females. The statistics suggest that while almost three-fourths of women in this age group have tried some sort of gambling in their lives less than 30 percent report this activity in the past month. Most men (86%) that are 60 or over in Indiana report gambling for money at some time in their lives and close to half report it in the past month; significantly higher than the rate of women. Males are also reporting trying more types of gambling for money in their lifetime than females.

It is a surprise that age was found to be indirectly related to frequency of lifetime reported gambling. One would expect that the longer someone has been alive, the more opportunities there have been to gamble. This may be due to the fact that there are many more opportunities to play games for money in recent years than there were years ago. However, this may also be due to recall error by the respondent who many not remember the rare instances of gaming for money in the past. It is particularly notable that current (past month) gambling by 60 though 65 year

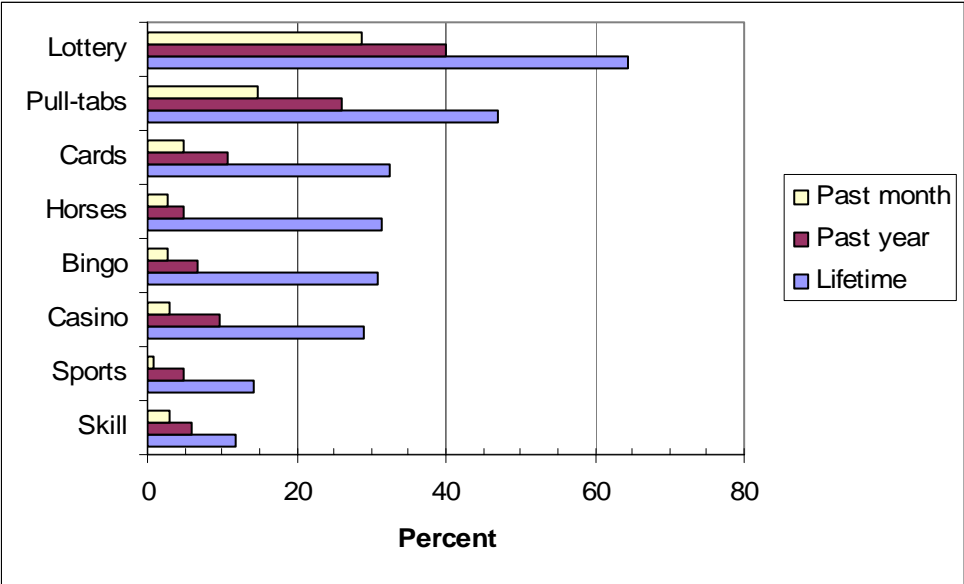
olds is almost twice as high as it is for those over 80. About half of those in their early 60's report having gambled for money in the month prior to the interview.

There are some interesting differences when comparing self-reported gambling in different geographic regions of the state. The counties along the Ohio River in South and Southwest Indiana have significantly higher rates of current gambling among seniors than the rest of the state. The counties in the Northeast region have the lowest rates; about 10 percent less than those in the south. Having a job is also significantly correlated with increased likelihood of gambling. It should be noted, however, that employment is also correlated with age so results for the unemployed will be similar to those over 65 years old.

The two most common types of gaming and betting for money reported by older adults in Indiana are playing the lottery and playing pull-tabs or scratch-offs. At least half of adults 60 and older have played one or both of these games at least once in their lifetimes. Playing cards for money, betting on horse races, playing bingo and placing bets at casinos have also been done at least 20 percent of this age group. Betting on college or professional sports and on games of personal skill round out the main types of gaming reported by adults over 60 in Indiana. Figure 2 displays the relative frequency with which older people report playing these games for money in their lifetime, in the past year and in the past month. These activities are arranged in decreasing order of lifetime prevalence. The remainder of this report will look at each of these types of gambling separately by gender, age, geographic region of the state and by employment status.

Prevalence of Playing the Lottery

The purchase of lottery tickets by people 60 and older is the most common form of gambling among this age group. Almost two-thirds of seniors in Indiana have played the lottery in their lifetimes and over one in four played in the last month. Although most women this age have played in their lifetimes, men are almost twice as likely to be playing the lottery recently as women. There is a significant drop in lottery popularity as seniors get older; those in their early sixties are more than twice as likely to have recently played compared to those over 80 years old. Over 90 percent of lottery tickets are purchased at gas stations (40%), convenience stores (32%) and grocery stores (22%). While there are some significant differences in lottery use throughout the state, its popularity is fairly consistent.

Prevalence of Betting on Pull-Tabs and Scratch-Offs

Pull-tabs and scratch-offs are the second most popular form of betting for Indiana adults 60 years old and over. Almost half have played this type of game for money in their lives. The game appears to be almost as popular among women as among men. Those who are in their early sixties are about three times as likely to have played in the past month as those in their 80's. It is consistently played throughout the state, though residents of Central Indiana are twice as likely to play that those in the Eastern region. Current employment status does not play a role in determining popularity of pull-tabs and scratch-offs.

Prevalence of Playing Cards for Money

Card playing for money does not appear to be very popular currently among senior citizens. While roughly one-third have played for money in their lives, only about five percent have done so in the past month. As with most other forms of gambling, card playing is more popular among men than women. However, there are other unexpected findings. Older seniors are more likely to report gambling at cards than those in their 60’s. Gambling at cards is almost nonexistent among seniors in the western region, but most popular in the east. And employment status is unrelated to recent gambling at cards.

Prevalence of Betting on Horses

While almost one-third of adults in Indiana in their 60's or older have bet on horses in their lives, very few continue to do so. Only about five percent have done so in the past year; half that in the past month. It does seem to be almost as popular among women as among men, with age not being directly related to activity. Seniors in Central Indiana are those most likely to “play the horses” as are those who are still employed. About 69% of those who bet on horses do so at the track while another 20% do so at off-track betting parlors. Approximately 13 percent of seniors 60 years old or older have taken a sponsored trip to a horse track or casino, regardless of whether they bet or not.

Prevalence of Playing Bingo

In spite of the common perception of bingo-playing among the elderly, particularly among women, there is little evidence in this study to support the stereotype. While women were more likely to report playing bingo for money than men, less than a third of the respondents report ever playing the game for money and less than three percent reported playing in the past month. Age was not strongly related to frequency of playing, though there were some notable regional differences. The most bingo playing appears to be reported in the Northwest and Southwest regions of the state, compared to Northeast, North Central and Central regions where very little is reported.

Prevalence of Betting at Casinos

Traveling to casinos to gamble is apparently an activity popular among few senior citizens. Only about ten percent report going to casinos to gamble in the past year with only three percent reporting doing so in the past month. While reported slightly more among men than women, it is an activity that decreases noticeably as people get older. The Southwest region of the state is the area where most this type of gambling is reported by those adults 60 and older. Employment status has no significant relation to casino gambling. Most of those with experience in casinos have been in casinos outside of Indiana (87%, mostly land-based) while fewer (56%) had played at Indiana's casinos (mostly riverboats).

Prevalence of Betting on Sports Events

Betting on the outcome of college or professional sports events is an activity involving few seniors in Indiana; mostly employed men in their early 60's. Only about five percent of adults 60 and older report betting on sporting events in the past year. Past month betting on sports was almost immeasurable, though this may be due to the seasonal nature of playoffs when betting is likely to be highest.

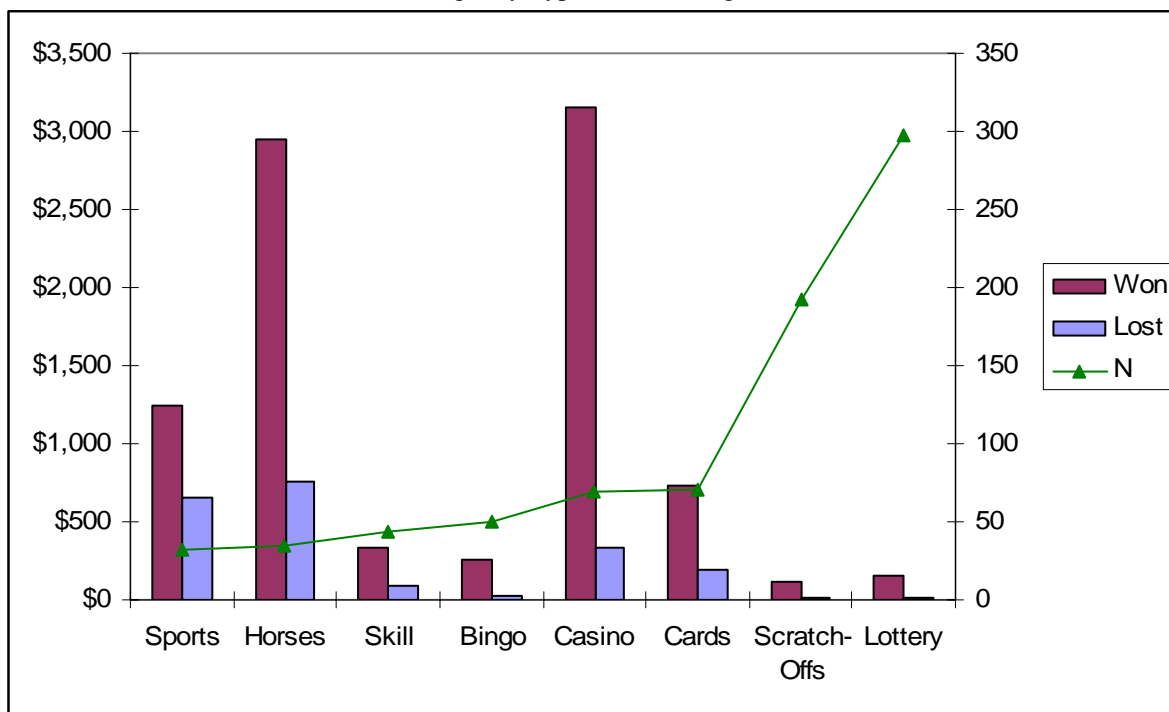

Prevalence of Gambling on Games of Personal Skill

Ever having betted on games of personal skill, like bowling, pool or darts, is the type of gambling least likely to be reported by seniors. Those who do are almost all male. Age has little to do with whether they participate in this type of activity, though it appears to be most popular in the urban regions around Indianapolis (Central) and Fort Wayne (Northeast).

Figure 3. Largest Amounts Ever Won or Lost by Seniors (60+) Who Have Bet in Past Year

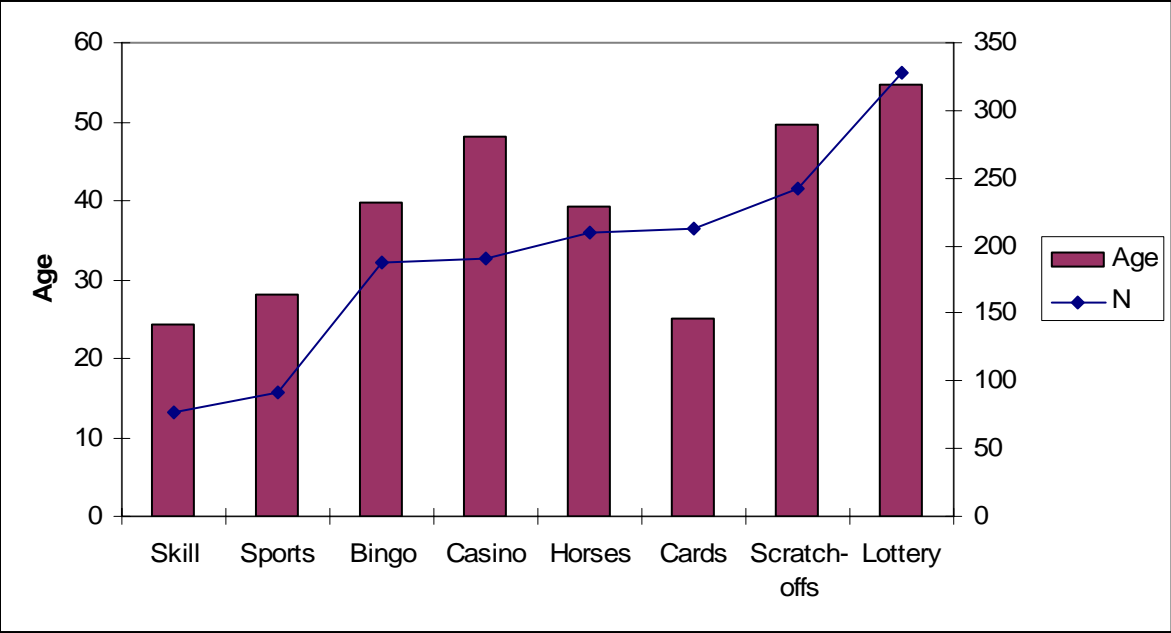
(Averages by Types of Gambling, 2005)



Largest Amounts Won and Lost

If respondents reported that they had participated in a particular form of gaming or betting in the past 12 months, they were asked two follow up questions: what was the largest amount you ever won at this and what was the largest amount you ever lost (or spent). Figure 3 displays the average amounts reported by those who had played any of these games in the previous year. The average dollars won or lost are shown as bars calibrated to the left axis. The line, calibrated to the right hand axis, indicates the number of people in the sample who reported having participated in this game in the past year. The largest average reported winnings were associated with establishment gambling at casinos and horse tracks. The games played by most people (lottery and scratch-offs) had the lowest average reported winnings.

Average Age First Gambled for Money

People who reported ever engaging in a particular type of gambling were also asked at what age they first played this game for money. The bars in Figure 4 show the average age at which people reported first playing that type of game. The line shows the number of respondents reporting they had played this game. Card-playing, games of skill and betting on sports were the types of gambling that started earliest. The games that are now the most popular with this age group, lottery and scratch-offs, are those that people began latest in life. This latter finding is probably due to the relatively recent widespread availability of these games compared to the others.

Problem Gambling

Respondents were asked to consider which age group was most at risk for serious gambling problems. Most (61%) felt it was people between the ages of 25 and 60. Another 27 percent felt it was younger people under 25 and the remaining 12 percent felt it was people over 60 years old. Regardless of which age group was likely to have the most problem with gambling, television was perceived as the most effective way to get information to these individuals. When asked if they knew who to call for help with gambling problems, only about one-third knew who they would call.

As of this writing there is no standard way to clinically measure problem gambling. To that end, a series of questions were included at the end of the interview to try to assess whether gambling had a measurably negative impact on the respondent. The questions (Q19-Q29 in the questionnaire - Appendix A) are based on the DSM-IV criteria for measuring dependency and abuse of alcohol and other drugs. Although these questions have been used in telephone surveys to measure statewide need for treatment for alcohol and drug abuse, they did not measure significant levels of gambling addiction. Only a handful of the 762 respondents answered positively to any of the various symptoms. There were some exceptions, such as “Did you set limits on how much you would gamble?” and “Did you ever want to try to cut down or stop gambling all together?”, but these questions alone did not warrant labeling someone as having a gambling problem.

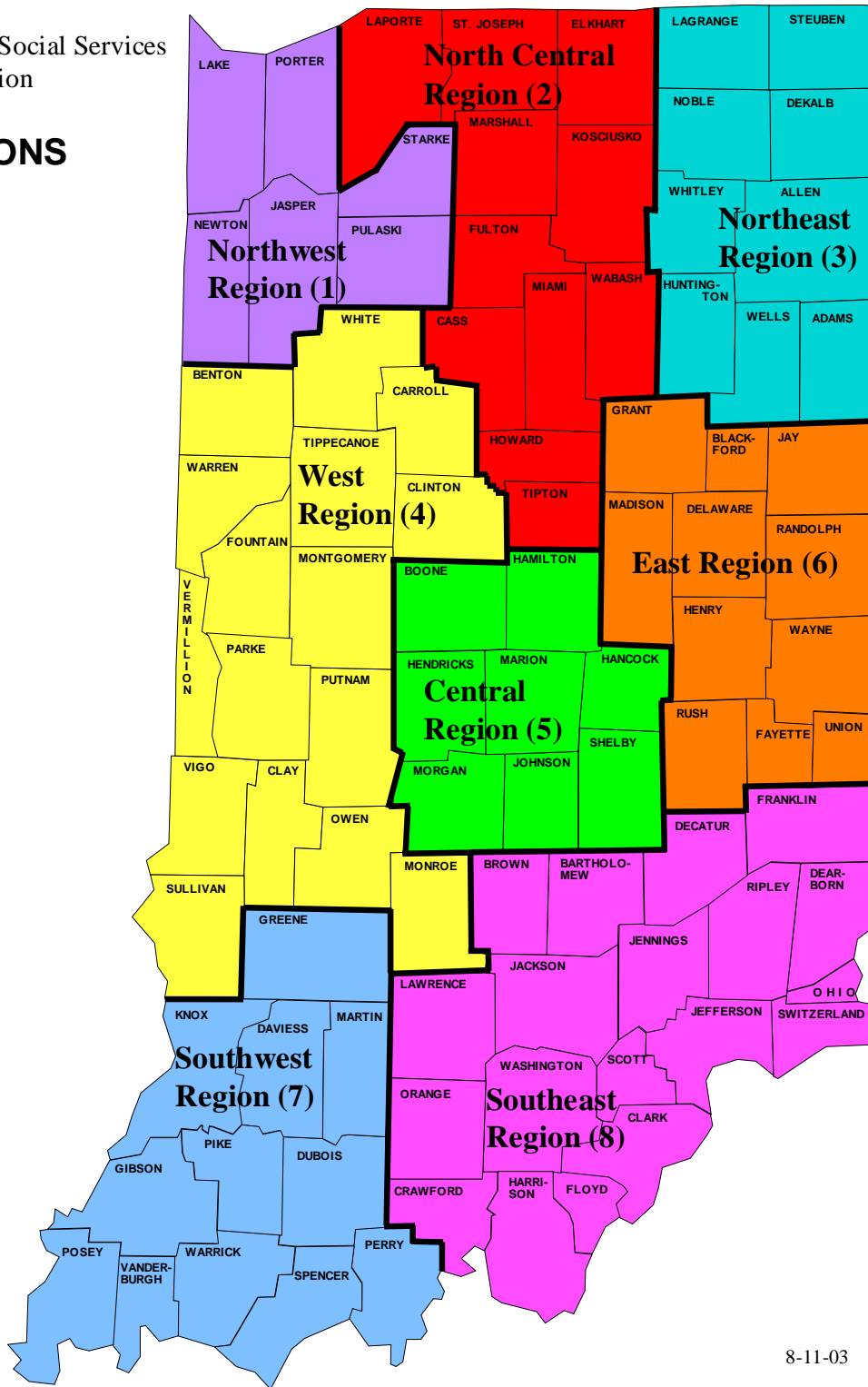
